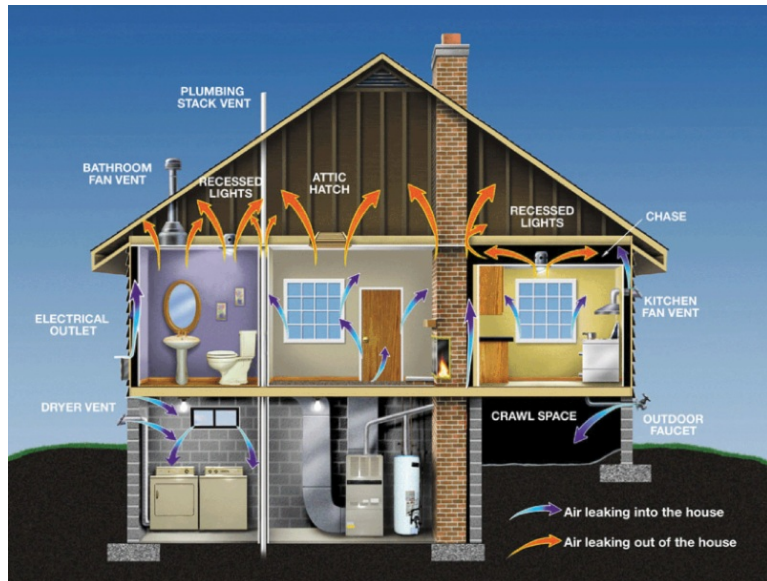
What Is a Home Energy Audit?

Energy Audit Steps:

1. Visual Inspection of building's envelope.
2. Insulation check, to find inconsistencies.
3. Air Leakage Test through entire home.
4. Ventilation Check.
5. Gas line check to ensure there are no leaks
6. Central Air System check-up.
7. Electricity monitor of household appliances.

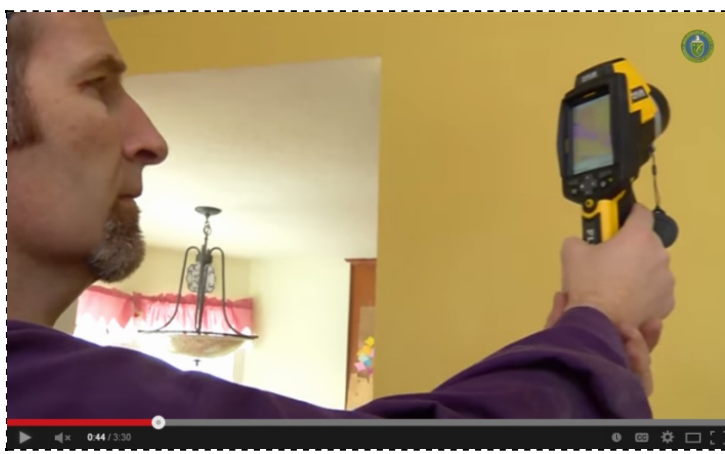
